

Prepare Engeltal

Engeltal, End-Time Handmaidens and Servants Headquarters, is a prophetic place and we've been experiencing devastating storms of rain and ice in the last 18 months that has given us the feeling we're in training for tribulation times.

Major flooding from continuous rain in March of 2008 destroyed our roads, flooded buildings and caused landslides. Just when the county road crews got the roads fixed, another torrential rain would come—again and again.

We've been praying in agreement with the Heart of God for Him to pour out His Spirit on all flesh, and in the meantime He's giving us a prophetic picture of what that kind of outpouring looks like in the natural. It totally interrupts your agenda and completely changes the landscape!

Then during January 26-29, 2009, Engeltal was hammered by an ice storm that devastated a five-state region, decimating the trees and bringing down power lines. Many lost their electric power for weeks. About 1800 power poles were snapped off in our county alone. So many trees came down that roads were impassible for days until crews could get through with chain saws. It took two power company crews two days to clear our road enough to get in to repair the downed power lines.

We were prepared in many ways, having enough lamp oil and lamps to light our dwellings, and enough propane to fuel our gas cooking stove in our main kitchen. Unfortunately, areas we thought we had covered ended up in less than good success. Our two small generators that normally cover our water pump and other emergency needs didn't work. Our large, 1964 generator that we fired up to run a small portion of our office building (including our phone system), worked for a day and a half, then a part on it broke and burned out our fire alarm system. Sadly, the generator repair man couldn't find the part to fix it. It's just too old.

We have had it on our wish list for years to get a generator to run our community kitchen with it's walk-

in refrigerator and freezer and standard fridge and freezers, so we don't lose food when we have a power outage. Sadly, we've never been able to find one that our budget could bear.

The gals who live in that building were cold, and so was Sister Gwen in her house, until her son, Tommy, discovered that he had a kerosene heater for her to use and our neighbor brought over some fresh kerosene.

We are receiving estimates for the kind of generators that will run our office and community kitchen. We were afraid to turn on our computers because the old generator put out such "dirty" power that it would likely have done damage to them. We have a vision to be fully prepared for any eventuality.

Excessive rain in the past months has the weather forecasters predicting a strong possibility of another devastating ice storm this winter. We need to get Engeltal ready for the time to come.



Our 1966 Massey Ferguson tractor seems to break down nearly every time we try to use it. Our End-Time Servant, Bob Baldwin, keeps repairing it and making it run again to do the plowing, "brush-hogging" the pastures, or repairing our roads from the terrible washouts following all the rain. It is always amazing to see it get up and run again, but we surely would love to

have one that's more reliable, in fact, it's a need.

On a more exciting note, the word of the Lord to Sister Gwen in 2004 that Engeltal will become a World Revival Center, seems to be getting closer and closer. We're seeing more signs and hearing more words encouraging us to prepare for the coming outpouring.

Even though we've had a devastating ice storm, our winters are generally mild, and certainly milder than our neighbors to the north. Surely God is speaking to some of His children that they are to get into the place where they will be in the midst of the outpouring He is going to do here. If He's speaking to you already, don't hesitate. Just obey.

End-Time Prophecies from Russia

The following are excerpts from the book The Light Will Come from Russia by Gwen Shaw. Most of the prophecies in this article have come to pass already. You need to know what is yet to come. —Editor

Mother Barbara, Abbess of St. Mary Magdalene

Now and then in my life I have had the privilege of sitting in the presence of great saints. Because I have so much to learn and because I have a love for truth and knowledge I treasure these opportunities more than the finest gold.

For some time I had heard about Mother Barbara, the Abbess of the Russian Church of Saint Mary Magdalene on the Mount of Olives, Jerusalem. It was Rev. Roy Upton, a leading statesman of the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada, who first told me about her in January, 1978, while I was in British Columbia. After that I prayed for the opportunity to meet this great woman who held in her heart the secret, ancient prophecies of the end-time.

In September, 1978, when we took our End-Time Handmaidens and Servants pilgrimage to Israel, we spent several days in Jerusalem. During that time our End-Time Handmaiden, Naphtali and I visited Mother Barbara.

When we rang the bell on the great gate of the compound, one of the nuns living there opened it with a smile. A few minutes later we were sitting in the presence of this great lady. She told me that she was suffering from a broken leg due to a recent accident.

Because God always gives us abundantly more than we can ask or think, He gave us the added privilege of meeting another elderly saint of God who also was visiting her that day: Father Innocenti, a priest who had been born in Siberia, and who had lived in China. He also shared with us a little of his life and sufferings.

Mother Barbara's Family

I asked Mother Barbara to share with us some of the prophecies of the end-time that had been told her by Father Aristocoli, who had been her father-confessor while she still lived in Russia.

Mother Barbara answered me, "Father Aristocoli died in 1918. He prophesied during the days of the Revolution. He had known me since I was a baby, as he was a great friend of my father's.

"My father was a good man; he would give away everything. He built hospitals, orphanages, homes for mentally sick children, rest-homes for the older people, and beautiful schools everywhere. He was always giving something to someone. We lived in Moscow. I'm a Muscovite."

Father Aristocoli, the Priest Who Prophesied End-Time Happenings

"My spiritual father was the Bishop of the Kremlin, also a seer. His name was Father Aristocoli. In Russia we had a special monastery where there was a whole group of these seers who spent their lives in prayer. They all had these special gifts of God to know and see

of their rebellion against Him.) In spite of everything against her, while working in the field she meets Boaz; one of the wealthiest men in Bethlehem, and instantly she went from working in the fields to owning the fields! She went from reproach to honor! She went from sorrow to joy! She went from a woman without a future to a woman with a future! Ruth found favor working in the fields and that favor brought her out of the fields and into the palace. Favor is going to be what brings you out of the place where you are and into the place God has destined for you to be. Favor will be what causes you to get that promotion. Favor will be what causes you to get that new car, or new house. You are about to go into a season of divine favor — **God is about to open doors for you that have never been**

opened. This is the set time to favor Zion; "yea, the set time is come" (Psalm 102:13).

God gave Ruth favor and Boaz takes her to be his wife. Ruth conceived and Obed is born. Obed was the father of Jesse, Jesse was the father of David, and from the lineage of David — Jesus Christ Was Born. The road to your destiny may lead you through some places you don't want to go. Jesus did not want to go to the cross. Paul says in Hebrews 12:2 that for the joy that was set before him he endured the cross despising the shame. Jesus knew after the cross there would be a resurrection. God is not through with you. Your greatest days are ahead. "Weeping may endure for a night but joy cometh in the morning" (Psalm 30:5). ✨

into the future. They would know what was in the hearts of people and could do works of healing. They were wonderful people. He was what we called a *starets*.

“Before he became my personal priest, someone had asked me, ‘Who is your confessor?’ I answered, ‘The priest in the church.’ They said, ‘No, you must go to the Kremlin and ask the bishop to be your confessor.’ That bishop was Father Aristocoli, the friend of my father.

“I came to him and told him what they had said to me. He replied, ‘We must ask God to show us,’ and he went over to his church to pray, while I waited for him. When he returned, he said to me, ‘It is the will of God. But you must absolutely obey me in everything, even if you don’t understand.’ And this I did.

“On one of the times when I visited him he said to me, ‘It’s so good that you can speak English.’ (I had been able to speak English since I was a small child because I had been taught by my Scottish governess. She lived with us more than twenty years). I answered him, ‘Happily, I know three languages. I know German, French and English.’

“When I was thirteen years old, I gave my vow to God to be a nun. I said to myself, ‘What is there in the world? Nothing! It is empty! It’s better that I am a nun.’ I told this also to my father and mother; but because I was so young I had to finish my education.

“As I grew up, Father Aristocoli continued to be my spiritual advisor.

“One day he asked me, ‘Do you still want to be a nun?’

“I answered, ‘Yes, very much. You bless my friends all the time, but you always leave me out!’

“He answered, ‘That is because the convent in which you will live doesn’t exist. It is very, very far away. But you will go there. It will be in Jerusalem, and the first abbess will be an English one. It is good that you speak English.’

“This priest, and the others who were like him, were wonderful men of God. You cannot imagine what they were like.”

And then Mother Barbara pointed to Father Innocenti, who was sitting with us, and said, “This one is a little like them.”

I asked her to tell us what the holy men of Russia had told her about the end-times.

She answered, “I remember! I will tell you. Almost all the things that Father Aristocoli told me up to now have happened.”

“What Will Happen To The Tsar?”

Mother Barbara, remembering back to those days, said, “We talked about the Emperor (Tsar Nicholas). I asked Father Aristocoli, ‘What will happen to the Tsar?’

“He said, ‘At the time of the end, the emperor will be in the Kingdom of Heaven.’

“I said, ‘I am sure, because he will have such a difficult time.’

“And he said, ‘No, because his life will be like that. He hasn’t been arrested yet.’

“When the Tsar was arrested, I went to Father Aristocoli again, and asked him, ‘What is going to happen next?’

“He put both of his hands to his head and said, ‘Different things will happen!’ But he didn’t tell me that the Tsar would be killed. He didn’t want to upset me.

“Then, after that I asked, ‘Will he be a saint, and be canonized?’¹

“He answered me, ‘In God’s time, yes, because in God’s sight his heart was always pure, and he hasn’t done anything underhanded. He was always straight and honest.’

“And then he added, ‘you will be living where one of his relatives will be lying in peace.’”²

Father and Elder Brother Arrested and Sentenced to Die

“When my father and my elder brother were arrested, and both were sentenced to die in three days, I ran to see Father Aristocoli, and said to him, ‘My father and elder brother will be killed!’

¹ *“Will Tsar Nicholas be canonized?”*

In April 1992 the Patriarch of Moscow and the Orthodox Church Synod accepted the canonization of Alexandra’s sister, Elizabeth (Ella). The canonization of other Romanov martyrs of the Russian Revolution, including the Tsar Nicholas and his family, has been left open. Watch for it to take place in fulfillment of Bishop Aristocoli’s prophecy.

² *“You will be living where his relative will be lying in peace.”*

This “relative” undoubtedly is the Grand Duchess Elizabeth who died a martyr’s death. The man who carried her body to Jerusalem had no idea that he was fulfilling this prophecy. Her body rests today on the Mount of Olives where Mother Barbara lived all the rest of her life.

“He waved his hand and said, ‘No, no, no! You will be out, out, out!’

“I asked, ‘But where?’

“He said, ‘In another country.’

“I was astounded. I said to him, ‘It cannot happen! They are not letting us go. We have already asked permission to leave the country. How can we leave? Will it be legally?’

“He answered, ‘Yes, yes, absolutely! You will be expelled!’

“My father was interrogated. Horrible questions were asked him. My father told them, ‘I am a believer’ [in the faith of Jesus Christ].

“‘What!’ they screamed at him, ‘You, a cultured, educated man? How can you be a believer?’

“My father answered boldly, ‘Yes, and I will die a believer!’

“When they asked my father about his political beliefs, he said, ‘I am a monarchist.’ My father knew that to say these things was the same as putting a dagger into one’s own heart, because for this they killed.

“The interrogator asked him, ‘Why don’t you become one of us and work with us?’

“Father answered, ‘How can I? I told you, I am a believer. You are unbelievers. I cannot become one of you!’

“‘But,’ the interrogator said, ‘You told us quite honestly what you are, and we need honest people. We have very few.’

“My father replied, ‘I cannot do anything else. I can only tell you what I know about myself

“The interrogator answered, ‘Can you sign a paper?’ My father answered, ‘Yes, but what is in the paper?’

“The interrogator replied, ‘You and your family will be expelled from Russia.’

“My father came home, and the next day my brother came also, with the same paper from the other prison, where he had been held. He also had been interrogated, and had told them straightly who he was and what he believed. Later, we were able to leave, and we quietly did so. We did not have to ask permission again to leave Russia.

“Indeed, everything that Father Aristocoli told me concerning my life up to now has come to pass.

“He had said to me, ‘You will live, first in one country, and then you will go into another one, and then after that, you will go to Jerusalem, where you will live.’

“I asked him, ‘Where shall I die?’

“He answered, ‘Isn’t that all the same to you, in whatever ground you lie — Russian or Holy Jerusalem?’

“So I do not know where I will lie. He didn’t answer me. But I did ask him, ‘Will I see Russia again?’ And he answered me, ‘Oh, yes.’”³

About The Antichrist

“I told him one day, ‘Oh, Father, I am terrified of the Antichrist.’

“He answered me, ‘No, no! You will live a long, long time.’ (I will be ninety years old in two months). ‘But, you will not see the Antichrist. There will be a time in between. It will be a good time, and God will be merciful. He will again give help to the people. But you know human beings are not faithful to God. When it is good, they forget Him, and they begin to live careless lives, and to do those things which they should not do.’

“I asked him, ‘Will it be a long time before the Antichrist comes?’

“He answered, ‘I don’t know. But perhaps about fifty years, and then the Antichrist will come. But you will not see him. You will be dead.’

“Yes, everything happened like he said it would, up until now.”

Africa In The End-Time

“He asked me, ‘Do you know where Africa is?’

“I said, ‘Yes, of course.’

“He said to me, ‘There will be a terrible revolution there.’

“I said, ‘It cannot be. They are not a cultured people.’

“He answered, ‘The devil knows how to use anybody.’ Then he said that the Emperor of Ethiopia would be done away with.

³ “Will I see Russia again?”

Mother Barbara never lived to see Russia freed of Communism, nor did she at any time return to Russia in her lifetime. However, when Father Aristocoli said that she would “see Russia again,” He did not say that it would be in her lifetime. I believe that she has been permitted to accompany the “great cloud of witnesses” with whom the writer of Hebrews says we are “compassed about,” and that she knows more about what is happening in Russia than any of us do (Hebrews 12:1).

“I said, ‘But there is no emperor!’ (We, in Russia, did not call the Emperor of Ethiopia an emperor; we used to call him *mennelich*. That is his title in the Ethiopian language.)

“Father answered me, ‘He will be put down from his throne. He will suffer, and he will die. Africa will be a sea of blood. After Africa, it will be Europe that will suffer.’

England In The End-Time

“Because I was brought up by my Scottish governess, and loved her very much, I asked him, ‘What about England?’

“He answered me, ‘England is not Europe. At that time they will have a queen, you know, and she will be very, very good, and you must pray for her.’

“I replied, ‘All right, I will.’

“He said, ‘It will be very difficult for her. She will suffer and weep much.’

Then Mother Barbara said to me, “We are in the most difficult times now, before the Antichrist.”

America In The End-Time

I asked her, “Did he say anything about America?”

“He told me that not one country would be left without suffering.”

Israel

I asked Mother Barbara, “Did Father Aristocoli say anything about Israel or the Holy Land?”

She answered me, “He said, ‘Don’t be frightened of anything you will hear. The eyes of God are always on the Holy Land and on Jerusalem. It is His land, and not man’s. It doesn’t belong to anyone. Jesus Christ, the God-man, Incarnate, was there — and there He will be again.’”

When she told us this, we all rejoiced together, to think that He was returning right there on the Mount of Olives where we were.

Did Father Aristocoli See a Nuclear Explosion?

Mother Barbara told us a very interesting prophecy that Father Aristocoli gave her concerning a strange kind of explosion that would take place in the end-time.

“One day he suddenly said to me, ‘You know how the end will be? China and Russia will fight.’

I replied, “How can this be? Both are Communist?”

She continued, “Father told me, ‘It will happen. On the border, where three frontiers meet: India, China and Afghanistan, there will be a terrible blast. Terrible, terrible, terrible! It will be near Tien Shan, China. That is where it will take place.’

“I said to him, ‘Father, that will be the end.’

“He answered, ‘God will take whom He wants in one country, and then in another.’

“I said, ‘Father, it will be terrible if so many people will perish.’

“He replied, ‘But God knows whom to take, and whom to leave — both from the Chinese people, and the Russian.’”

Mother Barbara’s Last Visit With Father Aristocoli

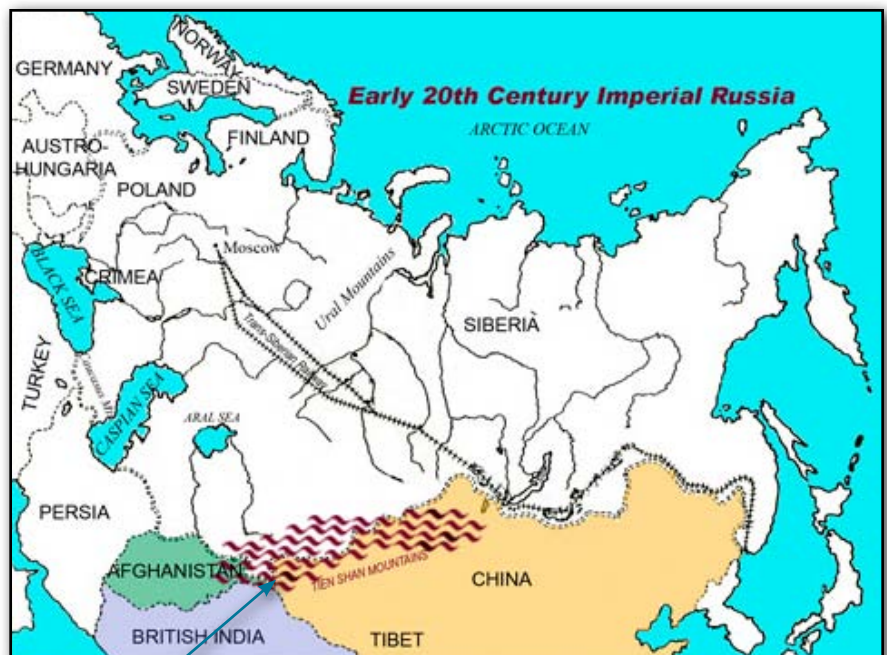
“The last time I went to see Father Aristocoli he was very sick. He was sitting up and resting. He took holy oil and anointed me with it. He anointed me several times — once for my father, once for my mother, once for my older brother and once for my second brother, and so on. I said jokingly, ‘Father, I am covered in oil.’

“He answered me, ‘It will help you.’

“I saw how feeble he was, so I said, ‘I will go.’

“Usually he would answer me, ‘My child, come again to me.’ or, ‘God bless you.’ But this time he only said, ‘Good-bye,’ and I wondered why.”

The Light Will Go Out to All the World from Russia

“When I got to the door, he called to me, ‘Come here a minute. You want to know about how the end will be?’

“I asked him, ‘About what?’

“He answered, ‘About Russia.’

“I came and sat near him, and he began to tell me about it: ‘We are Orthodox. How is it that people say the rays of light will come from the East? You know that from the very earliest centuries we have had prophecies that the rays of the Gospel light will come from the East.’

“I asked him, ‘What does it mean?’

“He answered, ‘I will tell what it means. Russia is an eastern country. Christ came also from the East. The light over the whole world will be from Russia, who suffered more than anybody.’

“I said, ‘But amongst us Christians we are all different religions.’

“He answered, ‘All will be one. I tell you, the light will come from the East.’

“He added, ‘Russia will be completely reborn! It will be an absolute rebirth of everything. The people will be reborn.’ Then he took a piece of my skin between his thumb and forefinger and said, ‘And you will be renewed, all renewed, and the skin, and everything, everything, will experience an absolute rebirth.’”

Jokingly, she added, “Now I often say to Him, ‘Father dear, it is a good time now to give me rebirth. Here I am sitting with my broken leg!’”

Then Mother Barbara turned to me and said, “I believe that after the terrible sufferings, which the Christians are going through, that they will all be like saints. Religion is a very great mystery, and the Russian Orthodox religion is the most ancient. The Light will come from Russia. I always tell the young people, ‘You will have a good time, but only be good.’”

“I and the Patriarch Will Bless the Church Together”

The political situation was steadily getting worse and worse in Russia. More and more people were being arrested, imprisoned, killed, or just plain disappearing. Even the Patriarch of the Russian Orthodox Church had been arrested and imprisoned. Therefore Mother Barbara was surprised when Father Aristocoli said to her, “I and the Patriarch will bless the Church together.”

Mother Barbara said, “I wondered how it could ever come to pass.”

Continuing on with her story, Mother Barbara said, “I told Father Aristocoli, ‘I will come and see you another

time.’ And he replied to me, ‘I don’t know if I will see you again.’

“In ten days he died.

“Because he was the Bishop of the Kremlin, and very much loved, the streets were filled with thousands of people who wanted to pay their last respects by walking past his coffin. I remembered how he had told me that he and the Patriarch would bless the Church together. I wondered how this could now take place, with him being dead, and the Patriarch still in prison.

“But on the day of Father Aristocoli’s funeral a wonderful thing happened: very early in the morning someone came and told me, ‘This night the Patriarch was thrown out of prison.’ He came immediately to the funeral and buried Father Aristocoli.

“I remembered how Father Aristocoli had said to me that he and the Patriarch would bless the Church together. This they did not do in the usual way, but they did it in a spiritual way. And I remembered how he had said to me at one time, ‘Many things are only done spiritually.’ I had wondered what it was, and then I understood when the Patriarch conducted his funeral service, that it had been a spiritual blessing for the Church.”

It was shortly after this that Mother Barbara and her family left Russia.

“Oh! What a Great Work the Women Will Do in the End-Time!”

I told Mother Barbara about my great burden for the women, and how the Lord had burdened me in Argentina, to pray that the Holy Spirit would call out ten thousand end-time handmaidens who would dedicate their lives to God, even unto martyrdom. She shared this with Father Innocenti, and he turned to me and said through her interpretation, “Keep your heart pure. That is the only thing necessary.”

Then Mother Barbara remembered something else that Father Aristocoli had told her, a message he had left for the women of the world — a message which she then passed on to me. He said, “Tell the women they must absolutely belong to God. They must believe in the great things that are happening, and what God is doing on the earth. They must prepare their souls, their children, and their husbands. And they will all have very much work to do for God. Oh! What a great work the women will do in the end-time! And the men will follow them.”

Mother Barbara was surprised when he said that, so she asked him, “What will the men be doing in the end-time?”

Father Aristocoli answered, “They will have other

things to do.”

Then she told me that many times women from different parts of the world visit her; and when they talk to her, they get stirred up in their souls, and go back home and arrange women’s prayer groups and fellowships. And God is doing a new thing amongst His daughters in these last days.

Father Innocenti Encouraged Me to Have Faith

Father Innocenti shared a little with me about his experiences in prison. While he was in prison, he met a Chinese monk, a good man.

It was a horrible place. In that prison was a man who had been a governor of that area at one time. He said to Father Innocenti one day, “I was a Communist and helped to build this prison. I put many people in here. And now I, myself, am here — and I am glad. Because when I helped to arrest and put people in prison, I noticed one thing, that it was only good people that I put in prison. Now that I am here, I realize that I must be a good person, too. How God changes things.”

Father Innocenti smiled at me, and said, “Only have faith, and everything will work out all right. I will pray for you.”

I asked her, “Have you ever felt you should write your life story?”

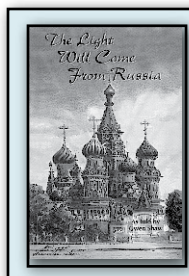
